

LEBSACK, WILLIAM FREDERICK

May 16, 1894-April 30, 1959

William Frederick Lebsack, long time resident of this community, passed away suddenly to his home April 30, as the result of a heart attack. Funeral services were held at the Congregational church May 4, with Rev. W.W. Heller of Torrington officiating.

The deceased was born May 16, 1894 at Brennendahl, Russia to George L. and Dortha Marie Lebsack and came to the United States with them in 1908 to live at Windsor, Colo. He married Elizabeth Dumler on December 28, 1917 in Ft. Collins, and in 1928 moved to Wheatland where he engaged in farming.

Survivors include his wife, Elizabeth; R.W. of Wheatland, Larry G. of the U.S. Army at El Paso, Richard G. of Wheatland, Stanley E. of the U.S. Navy in San Diego; six daughters, Pauline Dinges, Gill, Colo., Claire Zueck, Rock Springs, Edna Ward, Copeland, Kans., Delores Cundall, Riverton, Ruby Miller, Dwyer, and Glyda Gearhart, Casper. Sixteen grandchildren and one great grandchild also survive. One daughter preceded him in death September 19, 1939. One brother, Andrew, lives in El Paso, Tex.

Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery. Active pallbearers were Alex Weiderspoon of Ft. Collins, George Whitman of Windsor, Henry Schmick of Torrington, Carl West, Henry Lofing and Dr. Teal of Wheatland. Honorary pallbearers were six sons-in-law, Henry Dinges, R.J.
