Private memorial services for Maxine Myrtle Lee, 87, will be held at a later date.

Mrs. Lee died Sunday, February 23, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland, Wyoming.

Maxine was born July 30, 1915, in Broadus, Montana, the daughter of Samuel Arthur and Josephine Myrtle (Knight) Monroe.

She was reared and educated in Broadus; graduating from Broadus High School, and then attended and graduated from Black Hills State College in Spearfish, South Dakota, with a teaching certificate.

Maxine taught in various country schools in southeastern Montana and in the Headstart program on the Cheyenne Indian Reservation in

Montana. On Nov. 15, 1949, she married Dale F. Malley in Broadus; they divorced in 1966. She later married Glen Lee from Grass Creek, Wyoming.

Maxine moved to Wheatland in 1994. She enjoyed fishing very much.

Maxine is survived by two children, LaRaine Malley of Miles City, Montana and Sonny Malley of Wheatland; five grandchildren; and four great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, and a sister, Bernice Bilog in 2002.
