The many friends in this section of Mrs. Margaret LeSourd were grieved on Tuesday morning to learn of the death of that estimable lady, which occurred at Dr. Johnston's private hospital in Cheyenne. Mrs. LeSourd had been in poor health for some time and went to Cheyenne last week to undergo an operation, from the effects of which she failed to rally, death occurring on Tuesday morning at 8:30.

Mrs. LeSourd moved to Wheatland from Cincinnati, Ohio, after the death of her husband several years ago, and made innumerable friends in this section who will be grieved to learn of her death. She was of a kindly disposition and made friends with everyone with whom she came in contact, and her death leaves a void among a large circle of friends and relatives that will ever be felt.

The deceased was 57 years of age and is survived by three brothers, Thos. J. Carroll, Jas. Carroll and Owen Carroll, of this place, and two half-brothers, Geo. J. Carroll of Cheyenne, and Frank Carroll of Oklahoma. A step-daughter, Mrs. Fisk Alexander, resides at Xenia, Ohio, and a step-son, Frank LeSourd, lives at Cincinnati, Ohio.

The remains were shipped to Wheatland from Cheyenne on Wednesday morning, and funeral services were conducted at one o'clock in the afternoon at the Catholic church, of which the deceased was a member. The services were conducted by Father James Hermes of Douglas, and were largely attended by our citizens, the stores of the town being closed during the funeral hour. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
