

LEWIS, NAOMI B. FRY
June 21, 1901-August 11, 1952

Mrs. Naomi B. Lewis, wife of Orlan E. Lewis, died August 11, 1952, at her home 14 miles northwest of Wheatland, following an extended illness. Mrs. Lewis was born June 21, 1901 in Sigourney, Iowa, and died at the age of 51. She had been a resident of Platte County for the past thirty-five years and was a member of the Christian Church.
