

LEWIS, ORLAN EDWARD
September 11, 1892-October 15, 1959

Orlan Edward Lewis was born September 11, 1892, in Ravenwood, Missouri and passed away at the residence of Mrs. Mildred Garwood, 16 miles northwest of Wheatland, October 15, 1959, the result of a heart attack.

He was the son of Edward and Etta Moore Lewis. He was a veteran of World War I and the American Legion and had lived at his ranch since 1914.
