

LIBBEY, JENNIE LUCRETIA ENNIS

October 3, 1881-June 2, 1953

Mrs. Jennie Lucretia Libbey, 71, passed away yesterday morning, June 3, at her home following an extended illness. She was the wife of O.A. Libbey, commercial teacher in the Wheatland high school and had lived in Wheatland the past 22 years.

Mrs. Libbey was born in Davenport, Ia., October 3, 1881. She graduated from the University of Wyoming in 1918 and taught at the Laramie Northside school from 1918 to 1923 when she was united in marriage to O.A. Libbey. A loyal member of the Wheatland Methodist church, Mrs. Libbey was an active church worker during her years in Wheatland, having taught the young married people's class in the Methodist Sunday school for several years. She was an accomplished musician.

She is survived by her husband and one son, Robert, of Camden, N.J., a daughter, Mrs. Harry Mills of Hastings, Nebr. and three sisters, Mrs. H.M. Small of Denver, Mrs. Nettie Jarvis of Laramie, and Mrs. Frank Brown of Castle Rock, Wash. Four grandchildren also survive. Two sisters and two brothers preceded her in death.

Funeral services will be held Saturday afternoon at two o'clock at the Methodist church with the Rev. Howard Rice officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
