December 12, 1915-February 28, 1965

Doris Evelyn Smith, 49, succumbed in the WAF Base Hospital in Cheyenne on Feb. 28, 1965 after an extend illness. Mrs. Lieb was a life-time resident of Wheatland, and was a self-employed beauty operator before retiring. She was a member of the Women of the Moose.

The deceased was born to Mr. and Mrs. Walter H. Smith on Dec. 12, 1915. Her husband, Lt. Raymond J. Lieb was killed in action in Korea in 1951. Three brothers, Donald, Keith and Kenneth also preceded her in death.
