Services for Benjamin Lockman, 66, who died May 9, 1983 at Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne, were held Friday, May 13, at United Church of Christ with Rev. Ken Saunders officiating.

Benjamin Lockman was born in Fort Collins, Colo. on January 3, 1917, the son of David and Eva Mitchell Lockman. He received his education in Fort Collins and lived in the area until he moved with his family in 1936 to Wheatland where he farmed with his father.

In 1938, he married Esther Eichler and the couple farmed their own farm west of town for a short time. Later they relocated to their present farm northeast of Wheatland where he remained until his health failed this year.

He was a member of the Platte Manor Board, the Wyoming Mutual Insurance Board and previously served on the FHA Board.

Besides his wife, Esther, he is survived by one son, Benny Lockman of Wheatland; two daughters, Joyce Nolan of Wheatland and Carol Sanders of Powell; three brothers, Ray, Bill and Bob, all of Wheatland; four sisters, Laura Birkle of Wheatland, Irene Murray and Wilma Smith, both of Laramie, and Mary Wolf of Commerce City, Colo. and by eight grandchildren.

A brother, Walter, and an infant sister, Elizabeth, preceded him in death.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
