

LOFING, RAYMOND DALE
August 3, 1922-October 12, 1944

Platte County's first services for its war dead will be held Sunday at 2 p.m. from the Methodist Church for Raymond D. Lofing who lost his life in the European Theater fighting for his country, so that we may enjoy freedom a little longer.

Raymond was born in Ault, Colorado, August 2, 1922 and died October 12, 1944. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Henry Lofing of Wheatland. He came to Wheatland five years prior to entering the service and finished high school at Dayton, Wyoming in 1942. He was quite active in football and basketball.

The body will arrive by train Saturday morning under military guard. Military services will be held at the grave with an honor guard composed of former buddies of the VFW and American Legion posts. Rev. C.N. Last will have charge of the service.
