Tractor and Engine Club, Hi Wheelers Car Club, and Platte County Pullers. He donated his Cheyenne Frontier Days Commemorative Plates to the Old West Museum.

He is survived by his wife, Terri Lucy; son, George W. (Alison) Lucy III; and grandson, Samuel J. Lucy all of Laramie.

He was preceded in death by his father, George, on June 8, 1978; mother, Alvina, on February 13, 1978; brother, David Lucy; and grandson George W. Lucy IV.
