

NAFFZIGER, JOHN J.

January 6, 1842-October 17, 1918

J.J. Naffziger died at his home on Dry Laramie yesterday at the advanced age of eighty-five years. Death was due to old age. His daughter, Mrs. E.K. McDonald was summoned.

John Naffziger died at the home of his son, Joseph Naffziger, on the Dry Laramie on Oct. 11, 1918. He was born in Canada, Jan. 6, 1842. He was united in marriage with Anna Weidrick Sept. 27, 1866. To this union were born four children, all of whom survive him. They are Joseph D. of Wheatland, Mrs. Kate McDonald of Ault, Colo., Samuel A. of Otto, Nebr., and Mrs. Mary Elder of Hollywood, Calif. Mr. Naffziger was a messenger for the union army during the civil war. After the war he resided in Missouri until 1901 when he moved to Ault, Colo. He was a member of the Methodist church at Eaton, Colo. He was greatly beloved by all who knew him. Funeral services were conducted by Rev. McClellan Sunday afternoon, from the Longwith funeral parlors, and interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
