

NAFFZIGER, JOSEPH D.
October 14, 1867-October 12, 1921

Another pioneer of this vicinity passed to his last rest with the death of Joseph D. Naffziger, at his home on the Dry Laramie Monday morning, after a prolonged illness.

Mr. Naffziger was born Oct. 14, 1867 at Wheatland, Mo. About 29 years ago he came to Wyoming and spent a number of years on the Laramie plains. About 12 years ago he settled on the Dry Laramie ranch 14 miles west of town, where he resided until his death. He is survived by his mother Mrs. J.J. Naffziger, his wife and two daughters, Mrs. T.A. Coone and Marie Naffziger, also two sisters, Mrs. E.K. McDonald of Ault, Colo. and Mrs. J.S. Elder of Hollywood, California. While he was a very quiet and unassuming man, he was respected and loved by a large circle of pioneer people and his family mourn the loss of a kind and considerate husband and father.

The funeral was held at 2 p.m. today (Thursday) from the local Congregational church.
