

NELSON, BRIDGET CHRISTINA NYLANDER

1852-July 1, 1934

Funeral services were held at two o'clock today at the Wheatland Congregational church for Mrs. Christina Nelson who died Sunday, July first from a stroke of paralysis after only a few hours of illness. Rev. R.E. Morgan, pastor of the church delivered the funeral sermon.

Mrs. Nelson was born in Sweden in 1852, and at the time of her death was eighty-one years of age. She came to America 64 years ago and here has raised her family of nine children, all but one of whom besides her husband. S.J. Nelson, survive her. Ed, Emil and Charles Nelson and Mrs. Emma Duffy of Wheatland; William of Excelsior, Minnesota; Gus of Mountain Home, Idaho, Art of Sacramento, California; Mrs. Ruth Peak of Washington. Ray Nelson preceded her in death. She leaves two brothers; J.M. Nylander of Wheatland and August Nylander of Ogden, Iowa, who in company with a niece, Mrs. Clara Buech, also of Ogden have come for the funeral. She also leaves a sister, Mrs. Emma Owen in California and many other relatives to mourn her death.
