Charles H. Nelson, 87, pioneer Wheatland resident and retired business man, died at the Platte County Memorial Hospital of an extended illness on Sunday, May 17, 1970. He was born in Clinton, Ia. on Jan. 18, 1883, and moved to this area with his family at the age of 12. He was united in marriage with Jessie Ellen Freeman in 1910.

Mr. Nelson was affiliated during this time with the Congregational Church and the AF & AM No. 16, of which he was a 50-year member.

The deceased is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Helen Rosene of Wheatland and two sons, Donald R. Nelson of Portland, Ore. and Dean C. Nelson of Anaheim, Calif. Two sisters also survive, Mrs. Emma Duffy of Long Beach, Calif. and Mrs. H. G. Peak of Orange, California as well as five grandchildren and four great grandchildren. His wife Jessie Ellen preceded him in death in 1946.

Funeral services were held Tues., May 19, at 10:30 a.m. in the Schrader chapel, with Rev. Roger Stiers officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
