

NELSON, EDWARD ALBERT

May 2, 1893-October 5, 1942

(1949 Newspaper) The cremated remains of Edward Albert Nelson will arrive in Wheatland on Saturday and graveside services will be held on Sunday at 2 o'clock. Edward Albert Nelson died October 5, 1942 in the Woosung prison camp in Shanghi, China. He was born in Raymor, Colo. and had been employed by the Reed Construction company before the war. He was a veteran of World War I.

He is survived by two sons, Jay Nelson of Wheatland and Eugene Nelson of Los Angles, Calif., one daughter, Betty of Laramie; five brothers, Charles of Wheatland, William of Excelsor, Minn., Art and Emil of Sacramento, Calif., Gus of Mountain Home, Ida.; two sisters, Mrs. Harold Duffy of Los Angles and Mrs. Harvey Peake of Orange, Calif.
