

NICKEL, GLORIA JEAN  
April 10, 1945-November 22, 1966

Last rites for Gloria Jean Nickel, 21 year old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Karl Nickel were held at the Trinity Lutheran church on November 26, 1966 at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Elmer A. Ruscher officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Gloria Jean was killed in a one car accident 29 miles west of Wheatland en route home November 22 for Thanksgiving vacation. The 1960 Volkswagon she was driving went out of control on a curve and overturned several times, throwing her from the vehicle.

A lifetime resident of Wheatland, she was born here April 10, 1945 and was attending the University of Wyoming where she was a member of the Phi Beta Kappa sorority. She was also a member of the Trinity Lutheran church.

Many friends share the loss with the surviving relatives: Mr. and Mrs. Karl Nickel, the parents, a brother, Dennis Nickel, and sisters, Deborah Ellen and Sherry Louise, all of Wheatland.
