**Leo Nickle Succumbs**

Leo Nickle, 57, of Wheatland, Wyoming, died Monday, June 19, 1972 in Denver, Colorado, of an extended illness. Mr. Nickle had been a resident of Wheatland for the past 53 years. He was born in Scottsbluff, Nebraska on October 15, 1914. On June 9, 1938, he was married to the former Opal Pitts in Casper, Wyoming. Mr. Nickle was a farmer in Wheatland.

Mr. Nickle is survived by his wife, Mrs. Opal Nickle, three daughters: Mrs. Philip (Sharon) Jenkins of Wheatland, Mrs. Keith (Leoetta) Lammey of Cheyenne, and Miss Donella Nickle, of the family home. One son, Leon Kim, preceded him in death on August 31, 1969.
