

## Anna Lillian Nixon

Funeral services for Anna Lillian Nixon, 84, were held at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland Saturday, March 31, at 2 p.m., with the Rev. Dr. James S. Vuocolo officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Nixon died Thursday, March 29 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Wing following a long illness.

Mrs. Nixon was born April 27, 1905, the daughter of Ed and Elizabeth (Vincent) Reed at Hebron, Neb. At a very early age, she and her parents moved to the Lingle area where she received her education.

In 1923, she married Glenn Nixon in Lingle. For a short time they farmed and then moved to Torrington, and later to Wheatland in 1928, where they remained for the rest of their lives.

She was a member of the Eastern Star organization, the Dorcas Society, and the American Legion Auxiliary. She is survived by her son, Jack Nixon of Wheatland, three grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
