

NOE, LEENNO KATHERINE WICK  
December 9, 1894-December 7, 1961

A sudden heart attack claimed the life of Mrs. Leenno Katherine Noe, 66, of 702 15<sup>th</sup> St., who collapsed and died near the West Side Grocery last Thursday, Dec. 7, as she was walking home from the store.

The daughter of George Wick and Mae Sybrant, Mrs. Noe was born in Hyattville, Penn. and had made her home here the past 11 years. Prior to residing here, she had lived in Valentine, Nebr., and had lived in Wheatland once before from 1918 to 1921. She was a member of the Catholic church.

Funeral services were held at St. Patrick's church Monday, Dec. 11 at 10 a.m., Father Leonard Wren officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Pallbearers were William Howard, Manuel Rodriquez, Hugh Mullen, Jack Gorman, Harold Garret and Jack (unreadable).

Survivors include her husband, David A. Noe of Wheatland; seven sons, Edward of Denver, James of Los Angles, Calif., Frank of Cheyenne, Hugh Pat of Ronbury, Mass., Albert J., Julian of Los Vegas and Tim of Sheridan; also three brothers, Jess Wick, Bassett, Nebr., Herb Wick, Meeteetse and Floyd Wick. Two sons preceded her in death.
