

PAGE, MARTHA ANGELINE SMITH
February 29, 1856-July, 1925

The funeral of Mrs. Martha Page, former resident of the Wheatland Flats, was held Wednesday from the Longwith Mortuary, the remains having been shipped here from Casper to be buried, by her own request, by the side of a daughter, Mrs. Charles Crogan, who died during the residence of the family here.

Mrs. Page was born in Missouri on Feb. 29, 1856, her maiden name having been Martha Angeline Smith. She was married August 14, 1872. Later the family moved to Iowa, where her husband died fifteen years ago. Mrs. Page then came to Wyoming with a son, A.F. Page, with whom she settled on a farm a half-mile west of the G.T. Goodrich farm. Here they lived several years until they moved to Casper eight years ago.

Mrs. Page passed away Monday morning, cause of death being heart trouble and paralysis. She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Mary Lindsay of Casper, Mrs. J.W. Patterson of Casper, Mrs. Levi Egge of Red Oak, Iowa; and one son, A.F. Page of Casper.
