C.J. "Todd" Paradise passed away Thursday, Feb. 4, 1982 in the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

He was born April 19, 1903 in Newport, Neb. Todd was reared in Nebraska attending many schools there because his Dad's work kept the family on the move. In 1928, Todd moved to Wheatland and operated a trucking firm with his brother. He met and married Lorene Orr here on June 11, 1930. The couple then moved to Nebraska where they operated a grocery store for a short time. In 1940, they returned to Wheatland and Todd was associated with Russell Freightways and the Ringsby Trucking firms. He drove a truck in this area making deliveries during the construction phase of the missile sites. He then operated Mountain Motors, a used car dealership here in Wheatland prior to his retirement.

He is survived by his wife, Lorene, of Wheatland, a brother, Guy of Wheatland, and was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and six sisters.

Funeral services were conducted Monday, Feb. 8 at 10:30 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland with Dan Barcus officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial has been established to the Platte County Senior Citizens. The Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of the arrangements.
