

Lorene Orr Paradise

Funeral Services for Lorene Orr Paradise, 86, will be held Saturday, September 26, 1992 at 11:00 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Andy Gudahl of the First Christian Church officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Paradise died Wednesday, September 23, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after a brief illness.

She was born April 13, 1906 in McClelland, Iowa, the daughter of Henry and Sophia (Mathias) Orr. Lorene received her early education in Iowa.

In 1921, she moved with her family to a farm nine miles west of Wheatland. Her later education was in Wheatland where she graduated from high school in 1925. She taught at country school until 1930.

She married C.J. "Todd" Paradise in Nebraska on June 1, 1930. They moved to Cedar Bluffs, Neb. for a time where they ran a grocery store. They then moved to Wheatland where they had a small farm. Lorene also clerked several years at Garrett's Westside Grocery. Her later years were spent making beautiful ceramics, gardening, and caring for her dogs.

She is survived by four brothers; Ortha Orr of Carvallis, Oregon, Leland Orr of Casper, Willard Orr of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, and Bryce Orr of Wheatland. Other survivors include several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband C.J. Paradise on February 4, 1982, and one brother, Harold.
