

Perry Parsons Succumbs Thurs.

Perry Otis Parsons died on Thursday, June 27, 1970 from an extended illness at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. Funeral services were held on Monday, June 29, at 11:00 a.m. in the Memorial Baptist church with Rev. Bill E. Hamrick officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
