Funeral services for longtime Wheatland resident, Helen Edith Percy, 91, will be conducted at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, Nov. 8 at Gorman Funeral Homes - Platte Chapel in Wheatland, with Pastor Skip Perry of the United Methodist Church officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Saturday, Nov. 4, 2006, at Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Helen was born May 21, 1915, in Baldwin, Kan., the daughter of Louise (Bergen) and Orman C. King. As the daughter of a Methodist minister, the family moved quite a bit, coming to Wheatland when Helen was a young girl. She attended Wheatland High School where she was on the girl's basketball team. On May 27, 1932, she married Herbert Hadley Percy. Herb worked for Great Western Sugar so they moved some with his job; but, returned to Wheatland where they made their home, retiring in 1979. Helen's hobbies included sewing, knitting, crocheting, and beadwork. She

was a member of the United Methodist Church and past member of the Order of Eastern Star, the Rebekahs, and Royal Neighbors. She also enjoyed fishing, playing pinochle, and traveling with her husband.

Survivors include her son, Charles Percy and wife, Betty Lou of Longmont, Colo.; three grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, on Dec. 2, 1988; and two brothers, Charles King and Robert Curtis.
