

**Mexican Laborer
Drops Dead While
Working at Factory**

Eutiquis Perez, Mexican sugar factory laborer, dropped dead at about 8:30 Friday morning while working at the sugar factory.

According to information, Perez was unloading brick from a railroad car and fell over as if fainting. He was dead when medical aid reached him.

Coroner H. G. Watson held an inquest Saturday and a postmortem examination disclosed that acute dilation of the heart was the cause of death.

The deceased is survived by a wife and one son. He had lived in the Wheatland community for some time and formerly worked on the Grover Epperly farm as a beet tender.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home in charge.
