

PETTY, ADALINE WOODY
April 29, 1859-March 19, 1955

A woman who had been resident of this area since June, 1887, died in Cheyenne March 19. She was Mrs. Adaline Petty who died at the age of 95 years, following an extended illness. For the past six months she had made her home with a daughter, Mrs. W.W. Austin of Cheyenne. She was also the mother of Mrs. Lizzie Catlin and Mrs. Hattie Linton of Wheatland and John Petty of Chugwater.

Other children who survive are a son, Rahn Petty, Bend, Ore.; Mrs. Victoria Baldwin, San Tee, Calif., Mrs. Rose Selby and Mrs. Carrie Johnston, Winchester, Ore., and Mrs. Cora McKinney, Eugene, Ore. Other family members are a brother, Willis Woody of Nashville, Ga., 21 grandchildren, 30 great grandchildren and seven great-great grandchildren. Her husband and one son preceded her in death.

Mrs. Petty was born in Blue Ridge, Ga. April 29, 1859, and was a member of the Baptist church. Burial services were held Monday afternoon at the graveside in the Wheatland cemetery, with the Rev.
