

Jack Phillippi

Services for Jack M. Phillippi, 57, who died on November 7, 1986, in Casper, Wyoming, were held on Tuesday, November 11, at 2:00 P.M. in the United Methodist Church in Wheatland with Pastors Tom Blevins and Virgil Lamm officiating.

Born in Wheatland, September 12, 1929, Jack Phillippi was the son of John and Kathryn (Mitchell) Phillippi. He spent his childhood in Wheatland and attended school in the Wheatland area. From 1952 until 1958 he operated the family ranch and then he ran heavy equipment and sold implements. He moved to Casper to work in the same position and then in about 1962 he went into the mining business. He and Virginia Trenholm were married in 1953 and three children were born to that union. In 1984 he married Betty Wolff.

He is survived by Betty Phillippi of Mills, Wyoming, his wife; by Jeffrey Phillippi of Casper and John Phillippi of Cheyenne, his sons; Keith Wolff, his step-son of California; Virginia Faulkner of

Cheyenne, his daughter; his mother, Kathryn Baker and his sister, Bette Yust, both of Wheatland and two grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his father, a brother, Tuffy, two sisters: Mary Jean Rask and Helen Phillippi; and his step-father, Pete Baker.
