

PHILLIPS, MARY
1853-May 27, 1913

Mrs. Mary Phillips died of heart failure at her home near Wyman Tuesday morning, May 27, at the age of 62 years.

She had been enjoying her usual good health, and not complained of feeling ill. She was preparing breakfast Tuesday morning when she was stricken and died a few minutes later. Her two sons with whom she was making her home were at the barn doing chores while the mother was preparing breakfast, and when they returned to the house, found the mother lying prostrate on the floor. She died soon after being found by the sons.

The deceased had lived in Wyoming nine years and in the Wyman neighborhood the past three years. She is the mother of four sons and three daughters. Three sons live in this county, and one in Sterling, Colorado. Two of the daughters live in Nebraska, and one in Iowa.

The remains were brought to Wheatland Wednesday and will be interred in the Wheatland cemetery Saturday.
