

PIERCE, EDWARD C.
July 29, 1907-May 22, 1929

The entire community was shocked Wednesday morning, upon receiving the sad news of the sudden death of Edward Pierce at Laramie, this state. According to information learned, Edward was taken to the Laramie hospital Saturday night, and died from the effects of the flu, Tuesday night. Funeral services will be held from the Wheatland Methodist Church Sunday afternoon at 2:30 with Rev. Orman C. King preaching the sermon. Burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery and services there will be held by the local Modern Woodmen of America lodge, of which the deceased was a member. The Watson Mortuary went to Laramie Wednesday and returned with the body the same day.

Edward Pierce was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. Lewis Pierce of Wheatland, and is also survived by one sister, Mrs. Lewis Palmer who resides in Montana. Edward was 21 years of age at the time of his death and had lived in Wheatland for about 12 years. He was a member of the graduating class of the Wheatland high school in 1927 and was attending his first term at the University of Wyoming. He was well known to the young people of the community and was a member of the local Methodist church.
