

PIKE, ANNA MAE BURRITT
June 17, 1877-January 21, 1952

Anna Mae Burritt was born in Shelby, Nebr., June 17, 1877, one of eight children. She met and was united in marriage to M.U. Pike December 19, 1901, in Osceola, Nebr., and two children were born to this union. They came to Wheatland in 1918 and in December, 1951, celebrated their 50th anniversary.

Mrs. Pike died January 21, 1952, at her home, after a brief illness.

She was an active member of the Methodist Church and was W.C.W.S. president for two years.

She is survived by her husband, M.U. Pike, one daughter, Mrs. Lois Kennedy of Riverton; one son, Willis M. Pike of Wheatland; two sisters, Mrs. Neva Cunningham of Forest Grove, Oregon, and Zadie Burns of Garrison, N.D.; two brothers, Edgar Burritt of Merrill, Nebr. and W.A. Burritt of Woodstock, Minn. and four grandchildren.

Services were held at 2 p.m., in the Methodist Church with Rev. Howard Rice officiating.
