

PILCHER, VERA EVA BOYER  
July 21, 1895-October 1, 1980

Services for Vera Eva Pilcher, 85, who died Oct. 1, 1980 at Natrona County Memorial Hospital in Casper, were held Saturday at the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with the Rev. Virgil Lamm officiating.

Vera was born in Wisconsin July 21, 1895. She moved with her family to Kansas as a young girl. In Kansas she met and married James Albert "Bert" Pilcher. After residing in Kansas for a short time the couple moved to Wheatland where Bert worked for the county as an equipment operator. He preceded his wife in death Sept. 12, 1956.

After her husband's death Vera continued to make her home in Wheatland where she remained until the time of her death. She was a member of the Rebecca Lodge and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary.

Survivors include two sons, Richard of Casper and Donald of Longmont, Colo.; two daughters, Dorothy Sutton of Helena, Mont. and Marie Kornegay of Denver, Colo.; two brothers, Omar Boyer of North Platte, Neb. And George Boyer of Sutherland, Neb.; two sisters in Wisconsin; eight grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.

Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery.
