

PIPHER, WILSON RAY  
1875-February 10, 1937

Wilson Ray Pipher, former rancher of the vicinity southeast of Flattop, passed away at the Lusk hospital at 2:00 o'clock Wednesday morning, death caused by internal hemorrhages and heart involvement. Mr. Pipher was admitted to the local institution Tuesday, and was in critical condition at that time. He had taken ill at his ranch home and was rushed here as soon as the seriousness of his condition was learned.

Mr. Pipher's age at time of demise was 62 years, one month and 16 days. He lived in the Flattop neighborhood for the past twenty-one years where he engaged in farming and stock-raising. Surviving him are his wife and two sons.

Funeral services were conducted Sunday from the Chapel of the Watson & Dennis Home for Funerals, services being in charge of Rev. C.L. Morton of Guernsey, with Rev. J.L. Williams of Wheatland assisting.

Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery.
