

PLAGA, ALBIN R.
August 8, 1882-October 6, 1973

Funeral services were held Monday, October 8, 1973, at 10:30 a.m. at the Schrader Chapel for Albin R. Plaga with the Rev. Elliott Graves officiating.

Mr. Plaga, 91, passed away Saturday, October 6, 1973, at the Platte County Nursing Wing following an extended illness.

Mr. Plaga was born in Laramie, Wyoming, August 8, 1882. Mr. Plaga's parents were the first to homestead on the middle Sybille in 1886. Albin was one of the last of the old time cowboys who rode on roundup of the open range. He was a rancher, but was retired at the time of death. He married Mary Irene McComber on January 8, 1908 in Wheatland. He was a member of the Methodist Church and of the I.O.O.F. of Laramie.

He is survived by his wife, Mary Irene, and one daughter, Mrs. Robert (Thelma) Garton, also of Wheatland; two grandchildren, Steven and Greg Garton and two great grandchildren.

Burial was at the Wheatland Cemetery. Those serving as pallbearers were Jack Garton, Raymond Hanke, Owen McGill, Jack Radichal, Mick Miller and Elwood Hanna.
