

PREUIT, GROVER CLEVELAND
December 22, 1887-January 24, 1949

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) at two o'clock in the Congregational church for Grover Cleveland Preuit, 61, who died at the Wheatland hospital January 24.

He was born at Waco, Neb. on December 22, 1887 and had been a resident of this community for 28 years.
