WHEATLAND — Services for Myra Mildred Preuit, 80, will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Monday at First Christian Church by Ministers Andy Gudahl and Dan Driggs. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Preuit died Oct. 22, 1993, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland. She was born July 20, 1913, in Burlington Junction, Mo., the daughter of Don Austin and Ethel Valentine (Huston) Kingery.

She received her early education in Maryville, Mo., then the family moved to Wheatland in 1929 where she attended school. During that time, she was named Best Cook in Wyoming and won a \$5 gold piece. On April 5, 1930, she married Archie Preuit in Fort Collins, Colo. The couple farmed in the Wheatland area and Mrs. Preuit had a mail route for more than 15 years in the Plamer

Canyon and Uva areas. She also worked for many years at the Wheatland Sale Barn.

Mrs. Preuit enjoyed playing cards and cooking. She was a member of First Christian Church and Mountain View Farm Bureau Women's Club, and was a past member of the Rebekah's.

Survivors include two sisters DeLoris Preuit of Fort Collins, Colo., and Roberta Hahn of Arvada, Colo.; a granddaughter; one great-grandson; and several other relatives.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Archie, who died Dec. 9, 1971; a son Jackie Preuit; and a brother William Kingery.
