

RAWLINGS, DANIEL FRANKLIN  
February 17, 1857-November 30, 1935

Daniel F. Rawlings, one of the pioneer settlers of the Wheatland community, passed away on the last day of November, after an illness of some time.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon from the Baptist church with Rev. W.A. Pipkin in charge of the services. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Daniel Franklin Rawlings was born in Davis County, Iowa, February 17, 1857 and grew to manhood there.

In the early 80's, he moved to Saunders county, Nebraska and there was married to Mirah Elizabeth Scott, November 27, 1884. To this union five children were born.

He homesteaded in Holt County, Nebraska later and shortly after moved to Howard county where he was bereaved of his wife October 28, 1889.

In 1901 he moved to Wheatland where he spent his remaining years, passing away November 30<sup>th</sup>, 1935.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Lottie Royce of Wendell, Ida. and Mrs. Ruth Schultz of Lincoln, Nebr.; and two sons, J.O. Rawlings of Wheatland and H.L. Rawlings of Omaha, Nebr. He was preceded in death by W.A. Rawlings, the oldest child, on November 15, 1933. He is also survived by one brother, H.M. Rawlings of Central City, Nebr. and several nephews and nieces.
