

REERINK, JOHN HERMAN

1904-May 26, 1958

John Herman Reerink, 54, a former Wheatland resident, died suddenly in his home in Baltimore, Md., Sunday, May 26.

Mr. Reerink and his family resided in Pella, Iowa from 1910 to 1916 when they moved to Wheatland. He attended the Wheatland schools where he had a fine scholastic Record. He attended Grand Island Nebr. Business College and later accepted a position with the First National Bank in Hastings. He returned to Wheatland in 1934, and left for his grandparents old home, Baltimore, in 1944. He was a night watchman in a hotel in Baltimore. He was born in Sully, Iowa, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Lambert Reerink.

He is survived by two brothers, Carl and Albert, and one sister, Mrs. Lowell Clark, all of Wheatland.

His body will be shipped to Wheatland where services will be held Monday at 2 p.m. in the Schrader Chapel, with Rev. J.B. Milstead officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
