

REERINK, LAMBERT  
June 27, 1859-June 13, 1945

Funeral services will be held in the Schrader chapel Saturday at 2 p.m. for Lambert Reerink, who died in the Wheatland General hospital Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock where he had been confined for the past four weeks as the result of a broken hip. Mr. K.B. Matheson of Cheyenne will officiate and burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery beside his wife.

Mr. Reerink, who would have been 86 on June 27, was born in Lochem, Netherlands and came to the United States at the age of 23 first settling in Iowa. In 1915 he moved to Wyoming and purchased a farm one and a fourth miles northwest of Wheatland where he has since made his home.

He is survived by four sons, Bernard, Carl and Albert of Wheatland, and John of Omaha, Nebr.; one daughter, Mrs. Lowell Clark; one brother, Antoe Reerink of Arkansas, and two grandchildren.
