Funeral services were held Monday at 2:00 p.m. in the Schrader chapel for Elona Edith Rhoads, 78, who passed away in the Wheatland General hospital May 9. Officiating ministers were Rev. B.B. Byus and Rev. J.B. Milstead. Burial was in the local cemetery with the Schraders Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
