

RICHARDSON, VIOLA CAREY
August 18, 1870-February 28, 1951

Mrs. Viola Richardson, 80, who left Wheatland only a few months ago to make her home with her son Fred at Purdy, Mo., succumbed Tuesday of this week at Purdy following a stroke.

She was born in Indiana August 18, 1870, and became a resident of Wheatland in 1898. She was married March 8, 1893 in Pomona, Kans. to George Richardson, who preceded her in death March 6, 1942; just two days before their 49th wedding anniversary.

Mrs. Richardson was a member of the Methodist church and the O.E.S.

Surviving are her son Fred of Purdy, Mo.; three grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

The remains will arrive in Wheatland Saturday morning, and services, arranged by Schraders, will be held at 2 p.m. at the Methodist church the Rev. Howard Rice officiating. Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery beside her husband and a daughter, Mae, who died in 1930.
