Funeral Services for Barbara Frances Riley, 65, were held Thursday, December 3, 1992 at 1:00 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Gary Robbins officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Riley died Sunday, November 29 at her home near Wheatland following a lengthy illness.

She was born June 15, 1922 at Wheatland, the daughter of Benjamin and Etta (Fletcher) Lockett. She was raised in the Glenrock area and was educated primarily in Wheatland, graduating from Wheatland High School.

She attended Beauty School in Casper and after her training had a beauty shop in Yellowstone for a year.

She returned to Wheatland where she had a shop across from the Courthouse.

On June 4, 1950, she married Richard "Dicky" Riley in Wheatland.

She had her shop awhile then was a ranchwife full-time.

In 1970, she and her husband started Camp Dakota and she again had a beauty shop at the camp until 1983 when her health forced her to retire.

She enjoyed painting scenery, craftwork, crocheting and was a fabulous seamstress.

She is survived by her husband, Dicky of Wheatland and three children; Richard Charles Riley of Laramie; Barbara Ilene Loucks of Rock Springs and Adene M. Riley of Lyman.

Other survivors include two sisters, Eloise Miller of Glenrock and Iva Keller of Nampa, Idaho.

She was preceded in death by her parents, a sister, Mary Crawford and a granddaughter.
