

RISKEY, FRANK

July 4, 1841-September 20, 1931

Frank Risky, well known Wheatland resident, passed away at the home of Mrs. Fanny Belcher Sunday morning. Funeral services were held from the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home Wednesday afternoon and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery. Cecil V. Smith, pastor of the Christian church, preached the funeral.

Mr. Risky was 90 years old last July 4th and has lived in Wheatland a long time. He came to this country from Russia after his wife and children had died.

He had been in poor health for some time but until recently was a familiar scene on the business streets as he was very fond of visiting his friends and talking over old days. No trace of any relatives could be found.
