

RIZOR, WILLIAM ALMER  
September 15, 1898-June 27, 1964

Last rites for William Almer Rizor, a Guernsey resident since 1940 were held at the Guernsey Community church June 30 at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. John Warning officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery with the AF & AM No. 49 in charge of burial services.

Serving as pallbearers were Fred Kelly, Terry Kelly, John Reaner, Sylven Mathews, Lawrence Larson and Charles Lawrence. Honorary pallbearers included. E. McNall, Al Herman, Ben Nicola, Harry Runser, Francis Fronapfel, William Cook, Glen Gorman, Jerry Cunningham, Jess Hall, Carroll Schad, and Jack Dobbs.

On Nov. 2, 1925, Almer was married to Stella Hardee at Wheatland. His sudden death at his home, June 27, 1964, came as a shock to his many friends and relatives, although he had been in failing health since a heart attack in 1961. He was a kind and loving husband and father, unselfish brother, good neighbor and friend.

William Rizor was born in Spearfish, S.D. on Sept. 15, 1898 to William Albert and Minnie Eversull Rizor. He had been employed by the CB & Q Railroad for 42 years, and retired as foreman from the B & B Dept. He was affiliated with the AF & AM No. 49. Mr. Rizor was mayor of Guernsey for three terms and was active in civic affairs.

Surviving relatives include his wife Stella of Guernsey, a son, Elvin A. Rizor of Rancho Cordova, Calif.; and four sisters, Mrs. Elva David of Hat Creek, Wyo., Mrs. Frieda Storey, Ft. Collins, Miss Bernice Rizor of Rawlins, and Mrs. Charlotte Groshans of Scottsbluff, Nebr. There are also two grandchildren.

One daughter, two brothers and four sisters preceded him in death.
