Ruth Wilma Robbins

Survivors include four siblings: Roland "Corky" Sherwood of Wheatland, Jim Sherwood of Newburg, Oregon, Betty Carey of Lander, Wyoming, and Shirley Sellers of Hudson, Colorado.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Dexter in 1961; an infant sister, Dorothy Sherwood and, two brothers, Homer Sherwood and Barton Sherwood.
