Henry Albert Robeson died March 4 at the Veteran's Hospital in Cheyenne.

Robeson was born April 5, 1916 in Sandpoint, Idaho. As a child, he and his family moved to Lander. He attended schools and was raised in the Lander area.

He worked in the Civilian Conservation Corps for a short time, then became associated with the Bureau of Reclamation.

Entering the U.S. Army, Robeson served in the Philippines. And upon his discharge from military duty he returned to the Lander area where he worked as a restaurant cook and painter.

In the 1950s he moved to Jackson, then to the Wheatland area in 1976 where he spent his retirement years.

He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister.

Funeral services for Robeson will be Thursday, March 7 at 10:30 a.m. at Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel, Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Burial will be in Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial in his name has been established in the Wheatland Ambulance fund.
