

ROMIG, EARL NEWTON
August 8, 1890-June 3, 1962

Funeral services were conducted Wednesday from the Schrader Chapel at 2:00 p.m. for Earl Newton Romig, who died suddenly June 3. Rev. Vern Kruse officiated at the services and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mr. Romig was born in Esbon, Kans. August 8, 1890, and made his home in this community for the past 48 years, where he operated a wheat farm. He came here from Oklahoma. He and his wife Tessie were to have had their 50th wedding anniversary this July.

Besides his wife, he is survived by one son, Roger of Wheatland, and a daughter, Mrs. Burdette Hitt of Slater. Three grandchildren and four great grandchildren also survive.
