ROGER MILTON ROMIG

Services for Roger Romig, 67, who died in Wheatland, Sept. 14, were held at the First Christian Church Friday with Dan Barcus officiating.

Roger Milton Romig was born on the family homestead near Wheatland on Nov. 8, 1915, the son of Earl and Tessie Houston Romig. He was raised in Wheatland and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1933, having attended his 50 year class reunion this past summer.

He farmed with his father for a period of time then in 1939 he and his wife Evelyn (Dufford) purchased their own farm in the Gray Rocks area.

He operated the 8-Ball Pool Hall and Restaurant in Wheatland for a short time and has also been associated with Rumsey Transfer. For the past five years he has worked with Mike Johnston.

Survivors include his wife, a daughter, Venita Marker, a sister Agnes Hitt, both of Wheatland and three grandchildren and four great grandchildren.
