

ROUSE, ROSE ANNIE GOODIN
1848-May 12, 1922

Mrs. Reuben Rouse, aged 73, passed away at her home in this city Friday morning, May 12. Her last illness began with an attack of the flu in December. Funeral services were conducted by Fathers Phillips and George of Douglas in the Catholic church Monday morning and the remains were laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery.

A kind and helpful neighbor, a loving and devoted wife, a cheerful and consistent Christian, she is sorely missed by her husband and seven children, all of whom together with Messrs P.J. O'Connor and Otto Haas, sons-in-law, were present at the funeral, as well as by the grandchildren and a large circle of friends.

Rose Annie Goodin was born in Watertown, N.Y., of Irish parents. She came to Iowa when that state was in "the west". Later, with her husband and the elder children, she moved to Plainville, Kans., where for twelve years the family shared the common lot of pioneers and in 1894, settled on a farm four miles southwest of Wheatland where they lived until Mr. and Mrs. Rouse retired a few years ago. The children are: Charles, Agnes and Anne of Wheatland; Mrs. O'Connor and Mrs. Haas of Casper; and Ben of Riverton.
