

ROVED, LOUIS PETERSON

1847-January 11, 1934

The funeral for Louis Peterson Roved was held at two o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Congregational church, Rev. R.E. Morgan, pastor of the church officiating.

Mr. Roved was born in Denmark in 1847 and died in Wheatland January 11, 1934, being 86 years, 9 months and 29 days old. He was ill but a short time when death claimed him.

In 1893 he came to Wyoming and gained his start in life by working as a hired man at the wage of \$18 to \$25 per month. He homesteaded and later purchased more lands as his cattle increased from a few to a large herd, and thus he accumulated considerable of the world's goods.

He was never married and had only one known relative in this country, a brother, who died in 1926, about the time Mr. Roved made a dispersal of stock interests and became a resident of Wheatland. Mrs. H.E. Dearing was named his beneficiary.

The Copley Funeral Home had charge of the services and laid the body at rest in the Wheatland cemetery.
