

# Frank E. Ruby Dies In Nebraska

Frank E. Ruby, a rancher in the Platte Co. area died at the age of 76 at the West Nebraska General Hospital, Scottsbluff, Nebr. after a brief illness.

Mr. Ruby was born at Broadwater, Nebr. June 6, 1894 and has been a rancher here since 1950. He was a World War I veteran and was affiliated with the Baptist Church.
